

RESOLUTION 2017-12

ESTABLISHING PAY RATE AND BENEFITS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES

WHEREAS, for record keeping and financial auditing and accounting purposes, it is necessary to formally memorialize the current pay rate of all employees of the City of Marietta;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marietta:

1. Employees shall be compensated at the rate of pay, and eligible for all benefits prescribed by their employment classification pursuant to Chapter 2, Section 3 of the City of Marietta Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual, as follows:
